In coverage, he was fluid in transition and stayed tight to receivers down field. He routinely beat RB's to balls thrown to the flats without losing inside leverage.

He has good arm strength, and displays powerful velocity to intermediate and deep areas of the field. He did a good job going through his progressions and showed the ability to fit the ball into tight windows. He was the vocal leader for the QB group.

He was decisive, showed a quick release, and was not afraid to fit the ball in tight spaces. Arm strength was a positive, he routinely hit receivers in stride down the field.

Best all-around RB in camp.
